## Unconscious Bias



**DR. JOHN KREMER**

Dr John Kremer has developed considerable practical experience of dealing with equality and good relations issues in Northern Ireland. John works closely with a number of councils around Good Relations issues that involve sensitive Section 75 considerations, for example in relation to language, public realm schemes, emblems, memorials and flags.

He has worked directly with cross-border organisations such as Co-operation Ireland and Special European Union Project Board (SEUPB) on a range of projects, including PEACE IV, INTERREG V and PEACE PLUS. John has worked with the majority of public authorities in relation to Section 75, and provides support in this area with a number of high-profile bodies.

Within his seminar John will explore unconscious bias, the various methods they can take, how opinions are formed what we can do to become more aware of our own unconscious bias's
