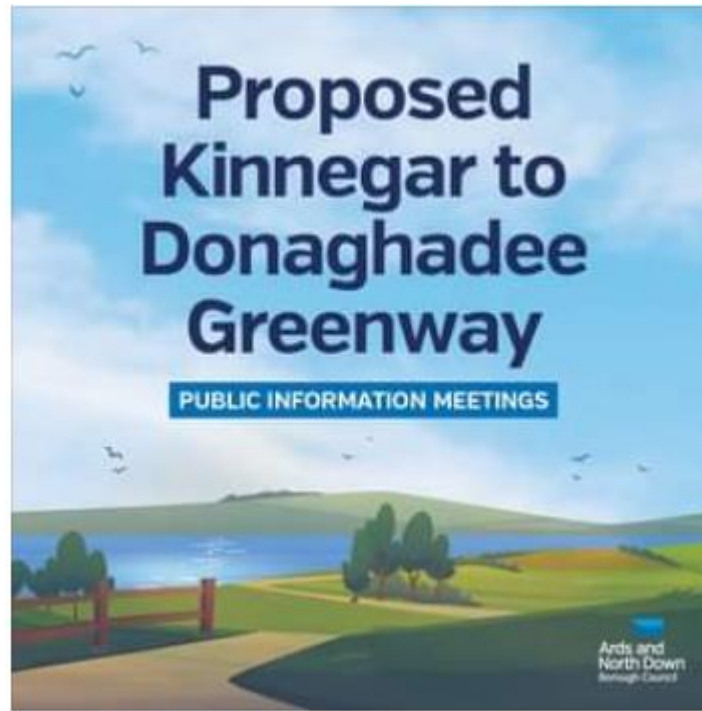

Thursday 26 January – Cambodia

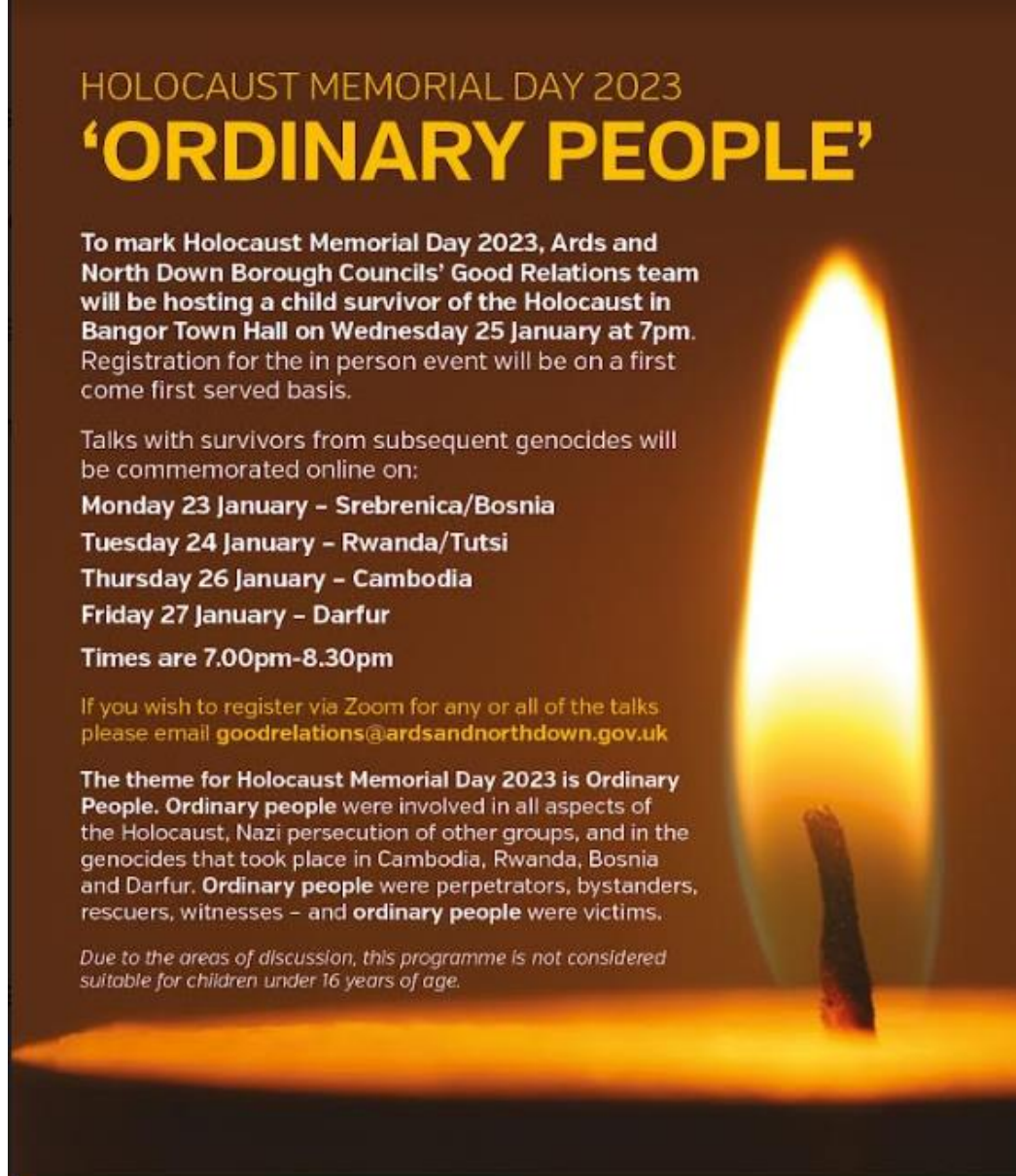
Friday 27 January – Darfur

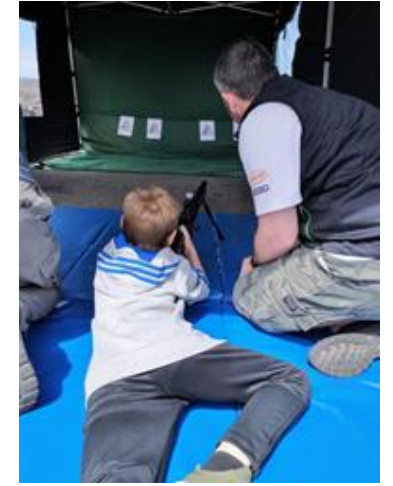


