We meet monthly to discuss key issues affecting the town, collaborate with local organisations, elected representatives, and statutory bodies—including Ards & North Down Borough Council—and drive initiatives that enhance our community. As a registered charity, our work is entirely voluntary, and every member plays a part in shaping the future of Donaghadee.

What have we achieved?

DCDA has been instrumental in making Donaghadee the vibrant community it is today. Our hard work contributed to Donaghadee being named the best place to live in Northern Ireland by *The Sunday Times*.

We have:

- **Enhanced the Local Environment**
 - Organised annual floral decorations, winning *Ulster in Bloom* four years in a row and a **Gold Medal in Britain in Bloom 2023**.
 - Led a major environmental project in **Crommelin Wood**.
 - Launched an £18,000 **Marine Litter Project** with local schools,
 - Planted a community orchard at Hunt’s Park
- **Boosted Community Spirit & Footfall**
 - Organised the **Summer Festival**, attracting nearly **20,000 visitors**.
 - Hosted the **Annual Christmas Parade** and festive celebrations.
 - Promoted **local shopping initiatives**, including the **Donaghadee bag**.
- **Advocated for the Community**
 - Pushed for solutions to **car parking issues**.
 - Addressed **coastal protection concerns** for the harbour and seafront.
 - Campaigned to **retain free bus passes for pensioners**.
- **Supported Local Groups**
 - Provided guidance on **funding opportunities** and **governance matters**,
 - Represented Donaghadee in the **Town Advisory Group** where issues affecting the town are discussed,
 - Created opportunities for groups to showcase their activities
