What we do

Our Committee meets monthly to discuss issues affecting Donaghadee.

Each member of the committee acts on a voluntary basis, giving freely of their time to improve the town.

Our key focus is on making Donaghadee a better place in which to live, work or visit. We want to see a vibrant town and we want to foster and promote community spirit and civic pride.

This involves us working closely with other organisations in the town, with our elected representatives and with statutory bodies including Ards & North Down Borough Council.

Why join?

There is much to gain by joining the Association. Membership is open to individuals, businesses in the town and community organisations. As an individual if you join, you can expect:

- The opportunity to contribute to community in Donaghadee.
- To have the opportunity to raise issues of concern and have these taken up with the Council or other body.
- An opportunity to influence future Council policy and practice.
- Information on events which may be of interest.

What have we achieved?

Owing to the pandemic, activities in 2021 were very restricted. Nevertheless DCDA has worked tirelessly to make Donaghadee a better place. For example over the past 2 years we have:-

- Organised the annual floral decorations winning Ulster in Bloom 2021;
- Co-ordinated the summer festival;
- Organised the annual Christmas Parade and associated celebrations;
- Distributed goods with a value of £7,000 for traders to use in our shop local campaigns;
- Worked closely with the Council on the introduction of various Covid Recovery grant schemes to support local traders;
- Secured funding to support the work of the Here to Help Group formed to help those most severely affected by the pandemic;
- Continued to work on our major environmental project in Crommelin Wood;
- Secured funding for a major Marine Litter project working with local schools;
- Following discussion with traders submitted a detailed response to the Government consultation on business rates;
- Campaigned for resolution of car parking problems – the Council's car parking strategy will be published soon;
- Helped support groups with advice on funding opportunities and governance issues;
- Worked closely with our counterparts in Bangor, Comber, Hollywood and Newtownards on issues of common concern; and
- Continued to represent Donaghadee on the Donaghadee Town Advisory Group which is the Council Committee overseeing the Townscape Heritage Initiative and discusses issues affecting Donaghadee
